

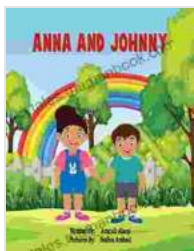
Anna and Johnny: A Journey into the World of Autism

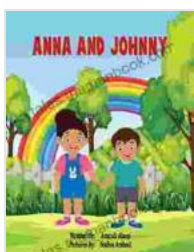
How You Can Help
