Step-by-Step Guide to Knitting Bed Socks with Plymouth F073 Baby Alpaca DK Yarn

Materials

- 2 skeins of Plymouth F073 Baby Alpaca DK Yarn (100% baby alpaca, 110 yards/100 meters per skein)
- 4mm (US 6) knitting needles (or size recommended by the pattern)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Instructions

- 1. Cast on: Using the 4mm (US 6) knitting needles, cast on 60 stitches.
- 2. Knit in the round: Join the cast-on stitches to form a circle, being careful not to twist the stitches. Continue knitting in the round, using your preferred stitch pattern (e.g., garter stitch, rib stitch).
- 3. **Heel flap:** Knit 30 rounds in the round.
- 4. **Turn heel:** Divide the stitches into three sections: 20 heel stitches, 10 stitches for each side. Slip the 10 stitches for the left side onto a stitch holder. Knit the heel stitches, turn the work, and knit back.

- 5. **Decrease heel:** Repeat the following steps until you have 10 stitches remaining on the heel:
 - Knit 8 stitches, slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit 1, pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch.
 - Turn the work, slip 1 stitch purlwise, purl 7, pass the slipped stitch over the purled stitch.
- 6. Reinforce heel: Purl 10 rows.
- 7. **Pick up stitches:** Pick up and knit 10 stitches along the left side of the heel flap. Continue knitting in the round, incorporating these stitches into your pattern.
- 8. Decrease toe: When the toe of the sock measures approximately 2.5 inches (6 cm), begin decreasing stitches. Knit two stitches together at the beginning of every other round until you have 10 stitches remaining.
- 9. **Graft toe:** Thread the remaining stitches onto a tapestry needle and graft them together using the Kitchener stitch.
- 10. Weave in ends: Weave in any loose ends to secure your work.


