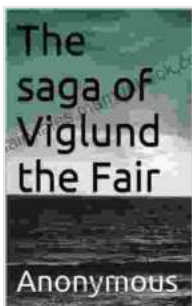


The Saga of Viglund the Fair: The Polar Bear

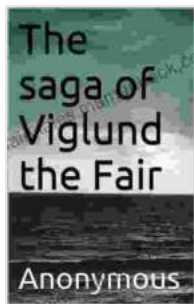

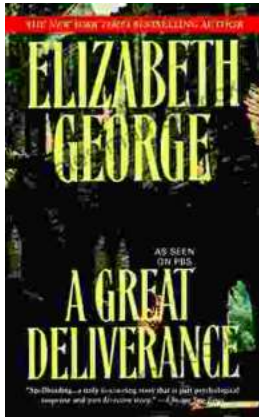
